#### Purpose:

Aggregate demand for ongoing lidar statewide, share experience and applications, and ensure better practice in acquisition, management, and use of lidar data.

### Goals:

- 1. Pa will have updated lidar statewide available to all by 2020.
- 2. PA will have a program for recurring acquisition and use of lidar or other topographic data.
- 3. Archive and management of topographic data will have long-term sponsors.
- 4. Interagency and intergovernmental training and application sharing will be commonplace.
- 5. Public, private, and academic sectors will interact freely in the Lidar Working Group.
- 6. Pennsylvania LWG will inform and learn from national and global practitioners
- 7. Pennsylvania LWG will perform advocacy, education, promotion on the value of elevation data to the economy, public safety, and environment
