## **Quick Information Updates**

#### 2019 Acquisition Status

Due to furlough the federal agency contracting is extended and eating into flying season. Still expecting substantial collection this season. Quantum still not 100% verified as vendor.

Two modest QL1 areas in the Allegheny National Forest to be collected with BAA areas.

## Member/Participant Updates

Maggie Dunn's job changed at FEMA so we will now have Lee Brancheau as LWG liaison.

2018 lidar data is nearly through QC including the last 3 counties contracted. Expect delivery to NRCS first sometime late March or early April

# **Data Acquisition Planning**

- Remainder after 2019 Acquisition
  - o FEMA High Priority 6215 mi. sq. 9 counties
  - o Western PA Remainder 8310 mi. sq. 11 counties
- Long-range planning discussion
  - o NRCS re-collect of Lancaster at 4 year mark a good benchmark for evaluation
  - PEMA nominal imagery cycle of 3-years offers potential for either 3 or 6 year refresh and imagery synchronized with lidar
  - Technology to allow same plane for imagery and lidar simaultaneous rumored to be in the works; current process does allow nighttime lidar collection – an advantage if collecting large areas
- Formation of Acquisition Core team
  - o Agreed that it should be Dane, Drzyzga, Blackmer, Hodder, Jespersen
  - Quantum should continue in role as technical resource when asked
