Project and use of water is located in Fredericksburg, PA

The purpose of this project is the renewal of Docket #19990701 issued July 8,1999.

Current ownership is and will be for the foreseeable future is Table Trust Brands, LLC.

Well 8 is an existing ground water source located in Fredericksburg PA.

This well serves as a potable water source for a poultry Processing facility.

Wells 2 and 6 are a Grandfathered water source (GF-202103157) used as non-potable water for the cooling of live birds and the washing of the cages and trailers. Grandfathered at 0.008 mgd as a maximum consecutive 30-day average.

Well 8 was drilled in December 1997, and penetrates blue quartzite of the probable Ordovician-aged, Hamburg Lithotectonic unit 3. The bedrock well is 8 inches in diameter, 500 feet deep and finished with 102 feet of casing.

Water from well 8 is pumped through a pumphouse where it is disinfected prior to being sent to a 400,000-gallon holding tank. Water purchased from the FSWA is also stored in this tank. The water from the holding tank is sent to the processing plant via three booster pumps to maintain proper pressure to the system. This water is used to feed the ice makers, cooling towers, boilers, scalding equipment, defeathering, evisceration process and chilling/disinfection of the poultry being processed as well as the

The project was approved for a water withdrawal (30-day average) of 0.20 mgd from well 8 and a maximum withdrawal (30-day average) of 0.20 mgd from all facility wells.

For the purpose of the renewal application, Table Trust Brands is requesting a withdrawal (30-day average) of 0.199 gpd and a maximum withdrawal (30-day average) of all facility wells of 0.199.

This is a decrease in the amount of water requested from the previous docket issued in July 1999.
